Hi Marie, Hi Pierre

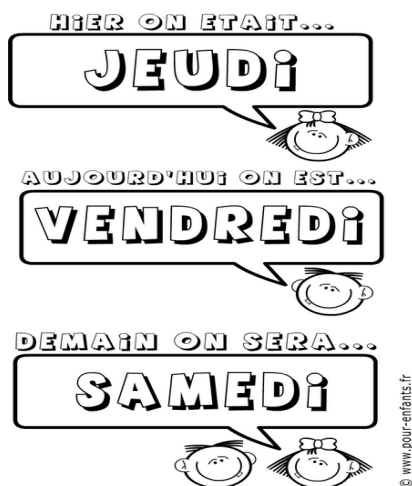


Marie, how are you today?

Ask Florence the question about the feelings (you can whisper: How are you Florence?)

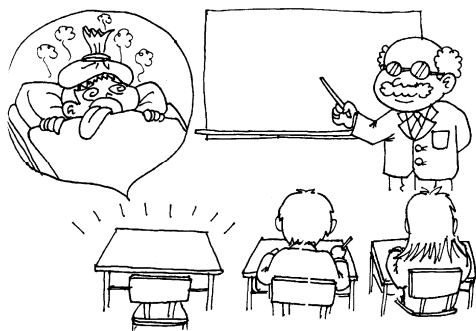
*Be careful: if you ask the following question which starts with "Why", it means that the pupils are able to answer by using either the past tense or even the future;
example: Why are you tired? Because I didn't sleep well. Why are you happy? Because we have sports today; because I'm going to the cinema tomorrow.*



Who can remember the question for the weather?
What's the weather like today?
Is it cold today? Is it windy today? Are you hot today?
What about yesterday? What was the weather yesterday?
Was it snowing yesterday?



What's the day today?
 Who can tell us the day?
 Who can say the seven days of the week?
 Is it Monday today?
 What's the date today? Today is Monday, January (the: said but not written) 1st
 Who can say the whole date?
 Who can say the complete date (sentence) , with all the information (day, month, number?)
 Let's say the twelve months.
 What was the date yesterday? (The day before today)
 What will be the date tomorrow? (The day after today)



Who is missing today?
 Who is missing today? Who is absent today?
 Is someone missing today? Is someone absent today?
 How many children (pupils) are missing today? How many pupils are absent?
 Who is eating at school?
 How many children are eating at school?
