



**Our problem**

Three classes of our school go to clean the shore.

They pick up 42 bags of waste in total.

The first class picks up 18 bags.

The second class picks up 11 bags.

**How many bags does the third class pick up?**

**Calculation:**

$$18 + 11 = 29$$

eighteen plus eleven equals (makes) twenty-nine

$$42 - 29 = 13$$

fourty-two minus twenty-nine equals (makes) thirteen

**Answer:**

The third class picks up 13 bags.
