Subject: Market

The game aim

One of the students in a team has to guess an economic word/ expression from a definition or information given by a pupil in another team.

The game rules

- 1. The teacher has prepared a few papers from which each contains an economic word/expression.
- 2. The team formation:

The game achievement

There are two rounds:

First round:

- One of the students in team A picks out a paper randomly and he reads it. Thus, he chooses one person in team B. He asks him to guess the word by giving him either some information or a definition. The student in team B proposes a word. In addition he has to make a sentence with it.

Note: each time player can get some support from his team, but in this case he loses marks!

- The round continues in the same way with other players in team A.

Second round:

We reverse the team's role:

Each pupil in Team B picks out a paper, chooses a person in team B who must find out the economic word ...

The game marks

- → Define the word: 2 marks, any support to define the word: 1 mark, not able to define: none mark;
- → Guess the correct word and make a sentence with it: 2 marks, any support to find out the word: 1 mark, not able to guess the correct word: none mark.
